Overview

Primary care providers face challenges managing infectious diseases like urinary tract infections (UTIs), multidrug resistant organisms (MDROs), and recurrent MRSA infections. Studies show that up to half of UTIs are misdiagnosed or inadequately treated due to errors in urine sampling or culture interpretation. The increasing prevalence of MDROs, such as ESBL-producing bacteria, makes it difficult to choose effective antibiotics. Managing recurrent MRSA infections is also tough due to changing resistance and varied treatment outcomes. This educational activity aims to improve providers' understanding and skills in diagnosing and treating these infections with evidence-based approaches.
