Katherine Wasson, PhD, MPH, is a Professor in The Neiswanger Institute for Bioethics and the Stritch School of Medicine, Loyola University Chicago and the Director of the Bioethics and Professionalism Honors Program. She served on the Board of Directors of the American Society for Bioethics and Humanities and is currently the treasurer. She is also a Co-Director of the International Conference on Clinical Ethics Consultation (ICCEC). She is the Chair of the Loyola University Health System Ethics Committee and the ethicist for the National Cancer Institute Central Institutional Review Board for Cancer Prevention and Control. She also leads the project on Assessing Clinical Ethics Skills (ACES) Tool for clinical ethics consultants developed at Loyola.
